ENGLISH



Following the Read Write Inc scheme, all children will have a daily Phonics and Guided Reading session.

Children will explore new vocabulary through daily shared reading from the 'Talk Through Stories' scheme.

Writing

Using the Get Writing scheme, children will be learning to write in simple sentences, using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

They will have spelling and handwriting practice three times a week

MUSIC



To know music has a steady pulse.

To know we can create rhythms from words, our names, favourite foods, colours and animals.

Children will develop their throwing, catching and rolling skills

Children will learn to move quickly and with agility

GYMNASTICS
