Sun Hats

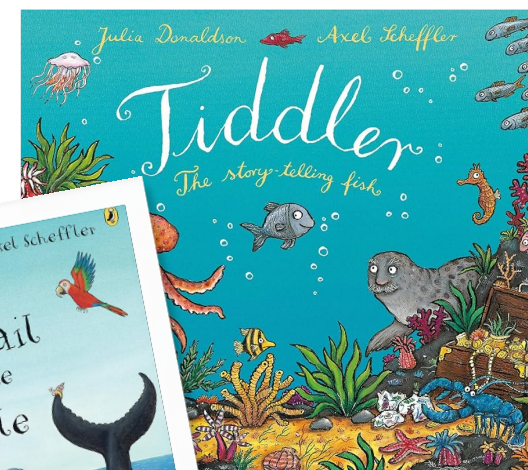
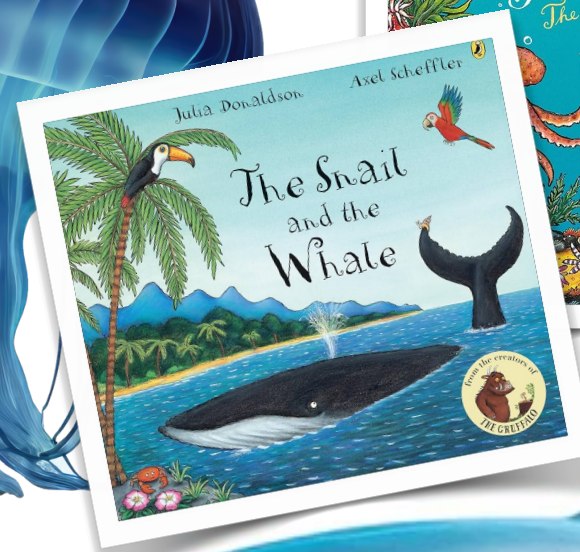
As the weather improves, please can you ensure that your child has a named sunhat to wear when outdoors.

Science

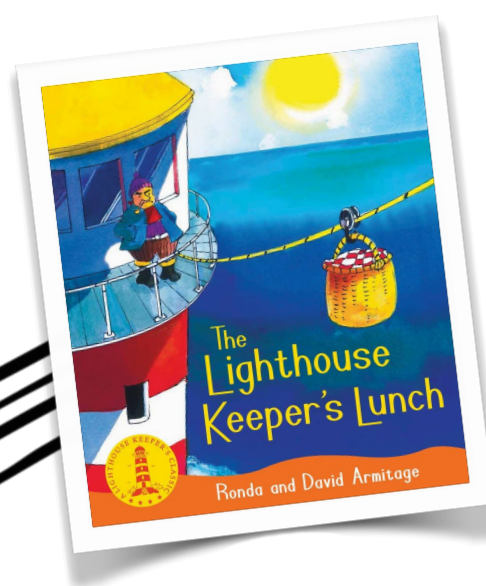
The children will be exploring the amazing creatures that live in the sea, classifying animals into groups and learning about their life cycles. We will also continue to plant flowers and vegetables and hopefully have something we can eat before the end of term.

English

We will be introducing the children to a range of books and physical objects to inspire our writing this half term. Genres we will cover will include, writing postcards, lists and letters to give opportunities for all the children to develop their writing skills. The Year 1 children will develop their knowledge of different spelling patterns this term. The Reception children will be writing their own sentences with capital letters and full stops. Read, Write Inc phonic sessions will continue as children consolidate the sounds they have learned

Maths

The Year 1 children will be learning about time and money this term, whilst the Reception children will be consolidating their knowledge of number and simple addition and subtraction number problems.



Design & Technology

The children will be designing and making their own lunch bags, inspired by the story The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch.

Geography

This term we will be exploring weather and climate. The children will be learning about the different types of weather, hot and cold climate zones around the world and how climate change is currently affecting weather patterns.
