### We are Reading: Street Child by Berlie Doherty

#### To continue to develop and secure:

Vocabulary: explain meaning of words in context of sentences  
Inference: using clues in the text to explain our impressions of character, action and plot

### SCIENCE - EVOLUTION AND INHERITANCE

To know that some characteristics are inherited, and some are adaptive  
To describe characteristics that they have inherited and those that are adaptive  
To know and recognise that there are variations between individuals within a species  
To know who Charles Darwin was and to simply explain what he noticed and how this developed his theory of evolution  
To describe how some organisms have evolved and adapted to their habitat  
To investigate 'beak' types and explain which 'beak' is best for picking up food

### Computing: Programming

To know that a variable is changeable and why it is used in a program  
To apply knowledge of variables to program a game using SCRATCH

### PE: Football

To choose, develop and implement a range of football strategies and tactics to attack and defend

### SPANISH: Presenting Myself

To use basic greetings in Spanish, ask somebody how they are feeling and reply when asked.  
To ask somebody their name in Spanish and reply when asked.  
To recall numbers 1-20 in Spanish.  
To ask somebody how old they are in Spanish and reply when asked.  
To ask somebody where they live in Spanish and reply when asked.  
To express our nationalities in Spanish and understand basic gender agreement rules

### History: Victorians with a focus on Crime and Punishment

To know when the Victorian period was and how it has shaped British History  
To explain what life was like in Victorian times for rich and poor  
To understand the jobs children had in Victorian times and the reforms that took place to change working conditions  
To understand how the Industrial Revolution affected Britain and the British People  
To explain how Victorian Reformers and Inventions brought change and how that affects life today  
To understand why crime was rife in Victorian times  
To know that the Victorians introduced prisons and that conditions and punishments in prison were harsh

#### Topic 1: Loving - God who never stops loving

To know and explore the love and care of people

#### JUDAISM (1 week)
